We invite avid photographers to come and push beyond their current creative parameters. Prior familiarity with your gear is paramount to making requisite adjustments on the fly as and when necessary, opportunities are often fleeting! Come prepared.

We encourage bringing along all your gear (tripod, pano-head, macro-rail etc.) so as to maximise on creative opportunities as/ when they present themselves... spontaneity is part of the plan. We regularly get down and dirty, venturing away from the vehicle on foot, to access what has drawn our attention. We are about capturing the essence of what we encounter rather than pursuing a specific shot-list.

With comfortable accommodations, scrumptious meals and amazing staff, any one of the Pafuri Camps is a perfect base from which to launch our exploration. Electricity is available for battery charging at both Pafuri Camp and Baobab Hill House, Hutwini Trails Camp however will make use of an inverter.
